



Remote Control Demolition Derby Rules

1. All RC trucks must be 1/10th scale. 2wd only, example: traxxas slash or other stadium style trucks.
2. Chassis, suspension, drive shafts, etc. Cannot be homemade. Aftermarket rc parts are ok.
3. Batteries and motors: brushless motors are allowed and nothing bigger than a 2s battery, single battery only.
4. Bodies and mounts: Body length max 26 inches, body width max 12 inches. Body mounts must be in stock location proline adjustable body mounts are ok, no homemade body mounts. Bodies must be made out of thin easily bendable metal example: metal for sale signs, soffit or flashing material for homes, it must be bendable. Single layer bodies only, overlapping seams to rivet body together is allowed, may use rivets or screws only to build your body no welding. You can make a 4 point cage within the body mounts with the same material the body is made out of, you may fold it 3 times ending width may be no wider than $\frac{3}{4}$ " corner gussets will be allowed on the inside of the cage. You can also run a skid plate made of the same material you may fold it 3 times ending dimensions no bigger than $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3". You can attach the skid plate with rivets or zip screws 3 on body and 1 on the chassis. Any extra bracing outside of the body mounts will be cut! Wagons no decking is allowed but you may run (2) $\frac{1}{2}$ " straps folded one time from your cage to the back panel, Must measure 5" minimum at the upper part of front fender with body mounted to the frame. With the body on the frame and battery installed car cannot be over 7 pounds.
