



OPEN DERBY SWINE SHOW

1. Exhibit owners must be FSQA or BQA (number required) certified.
2. Entries limited to barrows and gilts weighed and tagged on March 30, 2019. Recommended weigh-in weight range is 25 - 50 lbs. Weight outside this range will be accepted.
3. **Fair entries limited to three pigs per exhibitor. No limit to number of animals weighed in per exhibitor on March 30, 2019.**
4. **Swine must be entered on Wednesday July 17, 2019. All animals will need to be vet inspected/checked-in/weighed-in at this time.** Unload hogs in the Swine Barn. Pick up your check-in form at the check-in table in the swine arena and bring it with you to weigh-in animals and to have them inspected by the veterinarian. (No swine will be weighed on Saturday.)
5. Swine must weigh a minimum of 220 lbs. at show weigh-in. Lightweight pigs will not be eligible to be shown. Swine under 220 lbs. are severely discounted by the packer.
6. All swine weighing more than 330 lbs. at fair are not eligible to be sold through the county fair. The exhibitor will need to make arrangements to take those animals home. These animals are eligible for exhibition.
7. Swine will be judged live on Saturday, July 20, 2019.
8. Swine will be analyzed with "real time" ultrasound for carcass evaluation.
9. Final carcass placing will be based on rate of gain and carcass quality. Barrows and gilts will be evaluated together in carcass contest.
