- 1. Entries must be brought to the south room of the auditorium between 9:00 am & Noon on Wednesday, July 17th.
- 2. Contest is open to rural and urban exhibitors of Clinton County.
- 3. Entries limited to **one per class** for each entrant.
- 4. All entries must be grown by the entrant.
- 5. Entrants may enter as many classes as they wish.
- 6. Each entry must be clearly marked with Name, Class, Variety if known, Address and Telephone number.
- 7. Plates for vegetables will be provided.
- 8. Judging is from Noon on Wednesday, July 17 until completed. Judging is closed to the public.
- 9. Each class will be judged as follows: 1st (blue ribbon), 2nd (red ribbon) and 3rd (white ribbon). Each entrant will rec
- 10. A "Best of Show" ribbon will be awarded
- 11. Any unworthy entries will not be judged.
- 12. Entries may be picked up any time after noon and before 5 PM on Saturday, July 20<sup>th</sup>. Any entries not picked up will be destroyed.
- 13. All reasonable caution will be used to protect entries, but neither Clinton County Master Gardeners nor the Clinton County Fair Board will be responsible for theft or damages.

#### Class

- 29. Any Other Vegetable (not included in a previous class. No more than 4 entries per exhibitor in this class).
- 30. Vegetable Display (5 different vegetables grown by the exhibitor, with no more than 4 of any one vegetable for a total of no more than 20 vegetables displayed in any decorative box, basket or container no larger than ½ bushel. The exhibit will be judged 75% for the quality of the vegetables, and 25% for the decorative arrangements).

### **Herbs**

- 31. Parsley (3 sprigs in a bottle of water).
- 32. Any other individual herb (3 sprigs in a bottle of water).
- 33. Collection of 4 herb species displayed in separate bottles of water. Specimens should include 3 sprigs with stems of adequate length for each species.
